STUDENT LEADERSHIP



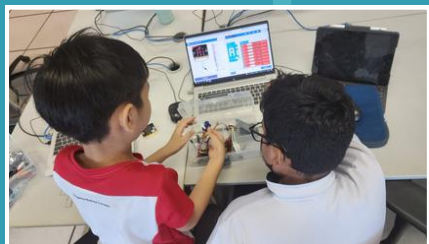
- Based on Kouzes and Posner's Leadership Challenge, student leaders (Student Councillors, CCA Leaders, Class Leaders and Peer Support Leaders) are developed to be competent, confident and caring leaders.
- Under the mentorship of Teacher Advisors, student leaders hone their leadership, communication and organisational skills.
- Opportunities include being Orientation Group Leaders, attending Leadership Workshops, Leadership Symposiums and the Peicai-Nanyang Junior College Student Leadership Collaboration.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH



- Through the Learn . Act . Pass it On framework, students develop as concerned citizens where they take on advocacy roles by initiating Values-In-Action projects, engaging with the community to understand and address real-world issues.
- In collaboration with community partners such as the Serangoon Neighbourhood Police Centre, Serangoon Community Club, Infocomm Media Development Authority, and St Luke's ElderCare, students work on meaningful initiatives that serve actual needs in the community.
- A notable example is the appreciation event for Bus Captains at Serangoon Bus Interchange, where students, in partnership with Ya Kun Kaya Toast, presented food to honor these unsung heroes for their hard work.

- The Unity in Technovation: Peicai-Zhonghua ALP Mentorship Programme sees our students utilise their expertise in computational thinking and inventive capabilities in crafting innovative digital solutions for real-world issues.
- Students develop their leadership and mentoring skills as they guide their younger wards from Zhonghua Primary School.

MR JOSEPHUS TAN BOOK PRIZE

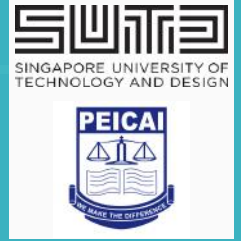


- The Mr. Josephus Tan Book Prize, in collaboration with Invictus Law Firm, recognizes and encourages students who excel in various areas.

Talent Development - PinnaCle

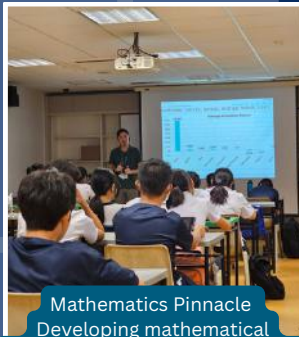

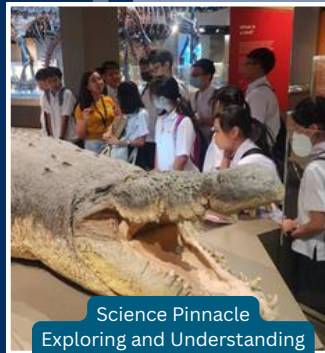
